It is a pleasure to write a letter of recommendation for Bricewood LLC and its owner, Kevin Reckinger.


We engaged Bricewood LLC to plan and carry out extensive updating of our two-story home in southwest Rochester.

The project, which was completed in two phases, involved installation of a hardwood floor (dining room and living room), several windows, six-panel doors, mouldings, a remodel of three bathrooms, (including a new tiled shower and cabinets), new marble kitchen counters, a staircase, and an exterior door. In addition a side overhead utility door was installed in the garage.

Throughout the project Kevin's crew worked efficiently and with great competence. Kevin always aims at perfection and rarely fails to achieve it. As with any project of this magnitude there are certain to be delays and glitches. In our case delays involved just one supplier (an exterior door that was replaced three times) and the minor glitches that did occur were solved to our satisfaction in a timely manner. The issue of the "unacceptable" door is only one indication of Kevin's persistence at staying with a problem until it is solved.

It should be noted that all this work was accomplished without the commonly associated problem of construction dust and dirt. When Kevin's crew was finished with the project, it was difficult to find any evidence of "construction residue." For this we were especially appreciative.

For his competence, knowledge, cheerful demeanor and willingness to solve problems that sometimes do not even involve his contracted work, we recommend Kevin Reckinger without hesitation for any project for which he, himself, feels capable.
